Family Study guide

OPENING TO GOD [2 Minutes]

Invite your family or group to sit in silence for 1 minute of silence. In the silence, encourage everyone to pray once, “Lord, speak to me.”

Then ask folks if they heard or felt like God was guiding them to think or hear something?

HOOK: Engaging the Topic [7-10 Minutes]

*Feel free to “pass” if you would rather not answer a question.

*Please be respectful of time and give everyone a chance to share.

Choose all questions to answer or just a couple.

1. Name 1 or 2 people you wish you could play or hang out with right now?
2. What would you want to do with your 1 or 2 friends?
3. Do you think your friendships or relationships help you experience or feel God’s love more or less?
4. Who do you think God is asking you to be helpful to?

BOOK: Engaging the Word [10 Minutes]

Read Acts 4:32-37

1. Today's Bible lesson reminds us to share what we have with the church so that the church can use it to help others. What do you think you can offer or give to the church so that God can use it to help others?
2. What do you think would happen if you gave away everything you own to the church?

LOOK: God cares about who your friends are. [7 Minutes]

God thinks you as very important and very valuable. This means that God sees you as a very helpful person to God.

1. What can you do to get to know God better?
2. Do you like your church or faith community? If so, who do you think about when you think about your church?

TOOK: [10 Minutes]

This week, pick a Bible character you like and draw a picture of that character.
