Senior Pastor Ponders...



The Season of Lent is upon us and as we take the opportunities to "fast, pray, and almsgive" as ways of deepening our relationship with God, centering our hearts on Christ, and finding ways to spiritually "retreat" so that we can recharge, revitalize, and reset our priorities in order to best serve God and others. That sure sounds like a tall order to do in just 40 days and 40 nights, right? It is, but it's a start!

We began the season of Lent with the Ash Wednesday reading from Isaiah 58, where we are invited into a different kind of fast, not only a symbolic one of fasting from eating, but a spiritual fast that challenges us to choose the fast that is life-changing and transformational that included praying and serving others as a way of deepening our relationship with God. In Matthew 4:1-11, Jesus began his transformational journey from his Baptism to his own "walkabout" as he wandered in the wilderness for forty days and forty nights to find clarity in God's call for him.

Our Bible studies pondered what it would be like to fast for over a month and then at the end of that fast be tempted by the evils of the world. We thought about how lonely it may have been for Jesus on this solo retreat without the creature comforts he had before called into the wilderness. We also explored our own Lenten wanderings from death and grief, to difficult decisions, trials, and traumas, and how important it was to note that even in the darkest of times, Jesus was not alone; he was with the Spirit and angels had been watching over him (verses 4:1 and 11!) Truly some heavy pondering happened in this first week of Lent!

And as we recognized how each of us has have "wilderness" and "wandering" moments, and that like Jesus, we too are not alone in these times, we discovered that with each wandering or wilderness moment, we have been given gifts. Gifts for the wilderness, if you will. And this month we would like to offer some gifts for our congregation...

This year's Lenten Disciplines for the month of March are our "Soul Care: Mini-Retreats" with each week offering a different "Taste and See" practice of Spiritual Disciplines from one of our ministries (or potential area of growth) that you may find piques your interest and you may want to incorporate into your life. (see pages 4&5 for details)

... Gifts for the Wilderness

Fasting and Prayer also offer opportunities for growth and transformation in the ways of giving back to God's community as well (almsgiving). In 2019, the Finance committee approved the exploration of a 501c3 non-profit status and Ad Council has been aware of looking into what kind of non-profit we want to be. Well, now it is your turn to Vision & Strategize with us. Using a process from the Kaleidoscope Institute that I have been trained on called, "Holy Currencies," Faith will be invited to explore what our church, our neighborhood, our South Bay Community could look like as a Neighboring Community Center. Could it be an opportunity to expand in our Senior Ministries, our Children, Youth, and Family ministries, could we offer holistic care as a healing center that offers wisdom and guidance, and mental health support? What are you interested in? What are the gifts that you could bring to the table to start this new ministry? (see page 12)

And as we find our way out of the "wilderness" we know that the season of Easter comes to us each year to bring us hope for the journey. And with that hope, we will be looking forward to our Holy Week offerings, and the new life that will spring forward in more Easter "Soul Care: Mini-Retreats," a new Baby and Me Group (for our Faith Keiki and their parents, grandparents, aunties/uncles, and even nannies!), Spring Membership, even preparations for upcoming fundraisers and a Fall Matsuri of Faith!

There is much to look forward to as we wander through Lent, and in the times where we feel like the journey is long and lonely, may we be reminded that we do not have to wander alone. For those of you that are struggling or have had challenges that have felt like the weight of the world on your shoulders, let Faith help you carry the load. With our Bible Studies and support groups, we also are hoping to connect you to small groups that will enrich your souls as well. If you have pastoral care, health, mental health, or caregiver needs, please do not hesitate to call any of the pastors or request support from the Church office so we can resource you. These are the gifts for the wilderness, for we do not need to journey on our own.

Participants are invited to dress comfortably, and bring a blanket/sleeping bag,

yoga mat, pillow, and/or eye mask if they so choose.

*Note about Sound Baths: If you have sound sensitivities, have had brain surgery, or a metal plate in your head, the frequencies of the singing bowls may affect you.

「3-3の日(賛美の日!)」

教会に参加すると、自分がしないであろうことをするようになります。一つは賛美です。毎週の賛美は私たちに歌を歌わせ、音楽に親しむようにさせます。(歌も上手になります!)そして、私は毎週礼拝のために何時間かけて、聖歌、賛美歌、賛美に目を通し、学びます。楽譜がない賛美は、自分で楽譜をおこすこともしばしば。それほど音楽、賛美は教会では大事なのです。

音楽で教えられることは多々あります。#は半音高くする時に用いられる記号。イエス様が十字架に上げられたことを表現する音に#を付けたのがバッハです。#記号の十字架は2つ。一つはイエス様。そしてもう一つは、私の十字架。イエス様の十字架と自分の十字架を重ね合わせ#になる。音楽を通し、日々自分の十字架を負い、イエス様に従うことが分かるようになる時が与えられます。(マルコ8:34)

旧約聖書で、心病めるサウロ王様は、少年ダビデのたて琴を聞いて慰められたと記されています。どうやって祈るのか分からない時、歌を歌うことによって、私の罪を赦して取り去って下さる主に祈ることが出来ます。イライラして感謝が出来ない時、主に感謝することが出来ます。落ち込んでいるとき、主に賛美して励ましを受けます。

人生、良い時と悪い時が必ずあります。どういう季節であっても、言葉が出なくても、祈れるようにと神様は音楽を下さいました。受難節、十字架を思い出す賛美を多々歌い聞きながら、信仰の歩みを深めたいと思います。

March 3rd is Girls Day. However, on March 3rd, we also remember the Day of Sanbi (Praise or Hymn) as the Japanese words fit perfectly for this day. At Church, we learn the importance of the sacred music and hymns. Weekly, I go over many praises and hymns. Music is very powerful; we often learn so much from singing or just listening. Bach, the great composer, used the #(sharp) every time the lyrics expressed Jesus on the cross. The # has two crosses. One is Jesus' cross and the other cross is ours. Therefore, when the # appears in music, it reminds us to take up our cross daily to follow Jesus who died for our sins. (Mark 8:34) During the Lent season, we would like to sing many Sanbi, to stay close to Jesus. And when we see # in the music, we will remember what Jesus, our Lord, has done for us on the cross. $\Psi \square$

A Lenten Journey Through Grief

'Amelia 'AhoSivi Faletau Finau, my dearest mother, passed away at 2:45am on February 22, 2023. This day was also Ash Wednesday. My family and I were not surprised that mom continues to remind us of the importance of this season, even on the other side of the veil. When I spoke with Rev. Allison later that day, she shared something that resonated with me. She said, "the passing of your mother on Ash Wednesday reminds us of our mortality—'dust we are and dust we shall return'."

It had me looking at my notes that I learned in my time with Rev. Allison and the Women's In Transition (WIT) group. I realized that if there were ever a season designed to help us move through grief after a loved one's death, that season would be Lent. I learned that just like the stages of grief we all must go through, Lent involves a series of passages: from darkness to light, loss to gain, fear to trust, sorrow to joy, and ultimately, from death to life.

Lent is a season that is deep and wide with passages that can help us walk through our grief. I believe this is my way of journeying through this lenten season and through this time of bereavement.

Moving from darkness to light

While it may seem far away as Lent begins, and far removed from the depths of grief, the hope and the faith that there is more than this earthly life, that death does not have the final word, does bring light into our darkness as we move through this season. I look toward the light and hold on in hope!

Moving from loss to gain

I should also remember that the measure of my loss is the measure of my love, the measure of my pain is also the measure of my gain, in the sense that our grief reveals to me the many ways my life has been blessed by the gifts and presence of my mother (our loved ones). Grief affirms not only what is lost but also what remains—the love, the gratitude, the memories, and the hopes.

Moving from fear to trust

When I feel caught in the grip of fear or anxiety because of my mother's death, I remember that Jesus too had his night of great fear and anxiety, his night of anguish in the garden of Gethsemane. Perhaps remembering his response—entrusting himself completely to God's care—this indeed shows me the path to take with my own fear.

Moving from sorrow to joy

Faith reminds us that joy is available even in the midst of our grief and loss because in God's hands, nothing and no one is ever lost. Separated from us for a time, yes, but not lost.

When we walk through this season with the support of loved ones, spiritual resources to nourish us (like our Soul Care mini-retreats), and an abiding trust in the goodness of God, we will indeed reach our own Easter Sunday of healing and wholeness. Though we may start our season of grief in ashes, it will be completed by our rising to new life.

RE-ENTRY UPDATE: MARCH 2023

With Gov. Newsom rolling back the CA State of Emergency related to COVID, Faith UMC will begin to adjust and ease our masking guidelines <u>AFTER EASTER</u> to also reflect what is published on CA Dept. of Public Health website:

When the end of Flu Season is announced, Faith will begin to "recommend and not require," people wearing a mask based on personal preference, informed by their own personal level of risk.

Vulnerable people*:

Consider wearing a mask in crowded indoor public places. Ensure your mask provides the best fit and filtration (respirators like N95s, KN95s and KN94s are best).

If you are a vulnerable person* or live with a vulnerable person*, consider taking additional precautions to keep them safe.

If you are feeling under the weather, it is always best to air on the side of wearing a mask in public. We also recommend that nursery caregivers wear masks to keep themselves healthy.




