I also asked our congregation that if they would like to do something tangible, they were welcome to fold origami cranes for peace and prayer. And in these two long weeks, I have received both daily prayers and cranes from both members, friends, and even Bishops! Take a look at the ones folded/shared by Kaira, Amara, Bishop Carlo Rapanut (Desert SouthWest) and Bishop Dottie Escobedo-Frank (Cal-Pac), and Rhoda Kai -- and to add to more signs of peace, everywhere I went I saw cranes (albeit building cranes!) all over Uptown Charlotte!

While we did the work of passing the REVISED Social Principles, and supporting our LGBTQIA+ siblings by REMOVING harmful language, and figuring out how to be a worldwide church as we REGIONALIZE all of our churches (WHICH WE DID!! Yay for the 3'R's!), the world around us did not stand still. We watched in horror how college and universities around the US, including local USC cancelled their graduation ceremony, and UCLA's encampments deemed illegal after students exerted their rights to protest and were arrested and attacked. We experienced the news about two mass shootings, one in a local Charlotte neighborhood where 8 law enforcement officers were shot, 4 killed; a Charlotte delegates had connections to the family of the slain officer. Clearly, we are crying out for peace in our world. The prayers is that our United Methodist Church continues to carry on the message that Jesus Christ has taught us about God's peace and love.

Clearly as I write this article, I am still at General Conference and look forward to coming home on Saturday to be with you on Sunday. It is for such a time as this that we have recognized that we are a NEW church with a mission to serve the world. I look forward to sharing more with you on Sunday when I return!
